## 1. Go into RPS and Mark Reports

2. To retrieve one Module, type the full module code in the boxes highlighted blue. Note the last box in campus ie LT181 4 AU CO, you do not have to input the campus code if you want all students on that module ie

## Retrieving Data for One Module



The following fields are available to include in your report but not standard, Show Cand Num (this is the exam number), Show Name and Show Flag. You can select them by clicking the appropriate tick box.

You can also choose to exclude certain candidates from your report by clicking on the "Include for Stats and Groups" tick box.

This data includes statistics for only the module retrieved and can be exported to Excel by clicking the "Excel Export" button. When in excel you can manipulate the data as you wish.

## PRINTING THE REPORT

You can still print the report and the statistics box for an individual module if you click on the PRINT FORM button at the bottom of the page. (Not shown on example above, but appears next to Text File).

## Retrieving Data for multiple modules

3. To retrieve multiple modules, click on the lookup $\square$ which will take you to the selection screen.
4. Select the modules by clicking the Selection box as indicated below.


You can also select by level of module by selecting the level required in this drop down list.
(If you make a mistake and want to clear all your selections, click the CLR ALL button.)

$7 \quad$ Which groups of students are included in the module statistics?
Students who are taking the module in the current year are included. Students who are being reassessed without attendance in a particular module will also be included. Students who are on the Grids but took and had ratified marks in a previous Stage Enrolment Record (SER) are not included.

Students who are absent from an exam are automatically excluded from the module statistics, but you can tick to include them if you wish.

Students who have been given a penalty for an academic offence are included. Bear in mind that this might account for why a student has a lower coursework mark. (For the future we are aiming to have an enhancement to allow users to exclude students with academic offences penalties if they so wish.)
