Location of the Health Centre

The Health Centre is located near The Houses and North Towers. It can be accessed from North Campus car park or Square 4 (from centre campus, via lift H64). The key facilities are as follows:

Access to the Health Centre from the main squares

From SQUARE 4:

- **On foot or by wheelchair** – take the path towards North Towers from the north side (between 4NW and 4N corners). Take lift H64 (inside Boiler House building) or adjacent external ramped path to the right. Once on the upper level, the Health Centre is located behind the first tower (Rayleigh) on the left.
