Q: Are the rooms furnished?

A: Yes, all rooms in University of Essex accommodation are furnished with essential items such as a bed, desk, chair, and a wardrobe.

Q: Is on-campus accommodation guaranteed for all students?

A: All first-year students are guaranteed accommodation if they apply before a certain date, allocation is on a first-come-first served basis so it's advised to get your preferred choices in at the earliest convenience.

Q: What support services are available for students living in accommodation?

A: The University of Essex provides a range of support services for students living in accommodation, including maintenance assistance and 24/7 security. There are also dedicated staff members available to address any concerns or queries including our Student Wellbeing and Inclusivity Service which you can access our drop-in service without making an appointment. We also have the Student Information Team in the Silberrad Student Services Hub.





Q: What is the difference between Enhanced and Premium?

A: Our Enhanced rooms have been refurbished. Our Premium rooms have bigger beds and our Premium Plus have more living space, as well as the larger bed. If you're not sure which one is right for you, visit our website to see photos of what these rooms will look like.

Q: What if I have specific needs?

A: We have a range of individual needs rooms with various adaptation, including:

- Wheelchair access
- Hearing impairment support
- Emergency call point/panic alarm
- Kitchen adaptations

- Automated doors
- Shower room features including adjustable grab rails – shower seats can be requested if not already available

Although every effort is made to assist in making reasonable adjustments to suit the needs of individuals, further funding and support may be required to arrange more specific specialised equipment.

Wheelchair adapted rooms are available at The Houses, South Courts, The Pastures and The Copse.



Once you have joined us at Essex, you will receive training and support to ensure you can start working in your role as soon as possible.


How to apply


