If you are due to graduate this year your final HEAR will normally be released during July following the Awards Board of Examiners.


Once your account is set up and you log in to **Gradintelligence** you should hit the landing page.

When you first log-in to Gradintelligence your HEAR Status will show as **Formative**. This will change to **Final** when you complete your studies and your final results have been agreed by a Board of Examiners.


To view your HEAR select **View my HEAR** icon and this will automatically open your HEAR.


