Journal Paper-based MAD – Full-time students

YEAR 1 REQUIREMENTS

1.	At the first supervision of the year, the supervisor(s) and student to carry out an
	analysis of the student's training needs for satisfactory completion of the MA by
	Dissertation and complete a training needs analysis form
2	Attendance:
	(i) Meet regularly with your supervisor(s), typically at least once a fortnight
	(ii) Attend twice-yearly supervisory panels (once a year for part-timers)
	(iii) Attend the Year 1 PhD colloquium and other relevant seminars.
	(iv) Attend any courses needed, including Proficio courses
3.	Complete the student sections of the Department's supervisory report prior to each
	supervisory panel.
4.	By the first Supervisory Panel at end of Term 1,
	(i) Produce an improved research proposal including indicating the
	significance of the research
	(ii) Where necessary, have submitted an application for ethical approval for
	the data collection for the journal paper
	(iii) Demonstrate the ability to produce work of the quality and quantity to
	complete a MA by Dissertation within one year.
5.	By the end of Term 1, in discussion with the Supervisory Panel, determine whether
	the planned research requires completion of the Covid Risk Assessment.
6.	Supervisor(s) and student to discuss student's career plans at least once during the
	year
7.	By the Confirmation Panel at the end of Term 3:
	(i) Have completed any data collection and analysis
	(ii) Have a full draft of the journal paper
	(iii) Have an outline for a seperate Introduction and Conclusion to the thesis.
	(iv) If a completion period is needed, have a detailed plan for submission
8.	The Standard Period for a full-time MA by Dissertation is one year
9.	The maximum Completion Period following the Standard Period is eleven
	months
10.	Completion Period:
	(i) You will only be able to have a Completion Period beyond the Standard
	Period if you have completed the tasks set out in 5 above.
	(ii) Completion periods are granted on a termly basis by the Dean for
	Postgraduate Research Education following a recommendation by the
	Research Students Progress Board.
	(iii) If a completion period is required, you must produce a clear plan for final
	completion with an agreed submission date

PART-TIME STUDENTS

The full-time requirements apply except that:

1.	The Standard Period for a part-time MA by Dissertation is 2 years and
	students have two part-time years to complete the year's work required for a full-
	time student. However, the maximum Completion Period for a part-time MAD
	student is eleven months, as for full-time students; however Completion Periods
	can only be requested on a termly basis.
2.	Supervisory panels are held yearly at the end of terms 3, 6, etc
3.	The Year 1 colloquium should normally be attended in the first year
