Variations to the Rules of Assessment

In respect of the course BSc Sports Therapy; in addition to achieving a Module Aggregate Mark of 40 or higher, students must pass the specified individual components of assessment in the module(s) listed below. No condonement is allowed.

Module Code	Module Title	Elements of Assessment which must be passed
PB102-4-FY	Introduction to Sports Therapy	Examination of the deliverance of first aid for a sporting environment (Pass/Fail, no weighting)
PB102-4-FY	Introduction to Sports Therapy	OSPE to assess massage techniques, thermal modalities and subjective assessment, and understanding of professionalism (50% weighting)
PB104-4-FY	Applied Anatomy & Pathophysiology for Sports Therapy	OSPE 3 Stations: 1) Identify bony landmarks on skeleton 2) Surface anatomy and muscle actions on model 3) Short viva (50% weighting)
PB104-4-FY	Applied Anatomy & Pathophysiology for Sports Therapy	Anatomy and Physiology MCQ exam

Students will be permitted with two further attempts following failing the first attempt. These attempts shall be capped, unless there are Mitigating Circumstances accepted as valid by the Board of Examiners. Resubmissions will normally be submitted within four weeks of students receiving their marked work.

A fail at final attempt will lead to a requirement to withdraw.
