One hundred window handles and 235 locks have been recycled from the Bertrand Russell Tower as the refurbishment project begins.

The locks, valued at around £400 each, and handles worth about £60 each, will be used as replacements in other accommodation blocks, saving us around £100,000 as well as benefitting the environment.
