

MA Jungian and Post Jungian Referral Bursary 2025-26

The University is offering ten £100 referral bursaries to current University of Essex students or alumni of the MA Jungian and Post Jungian Studies course, who refer an individual (prospective student) who subsequently enrols on either the online or Colchester based course in October 2025. The £100 bursary will be offered in the form of an Amazon voucher.

Terms and conditions

Eligibility

The referrer must:

- Be a MA Jungian and Post Jungian Studies, University of Essex, current student or alumni.
- Provide the full name and email address of the referred individual to <u>pps@essex.ac.uk</u>, no later than 10 October 2025. Note: The referrer should only share details of an individual where they have explicit consent from the individual (the prospective student) to provide contact data for the purpose of this service.
- Be contactable via email up to 28 November 2025 to provide up-to-date contact information for receipt of the award.

The referred individual (prospective student) must:

- Apply to the University of Essex via the direct application form, further information available online: <u>https://www.essex.ac.uk/postgraduate/masters/applying-to-essex</u>
- Register for the first year of MA Jungian and Post Jungian Studies, either for the on-campus and online variant of the programme, at the University of Essex in October 2025.
- Confirm to <u>pps@essex.ac.uk</u> the name and email address of the referrer by 1 November 2025.
- Be a new student to the University of Essex, registering for the first time in October 2025.

- There is no limit on the number of referrals an individual referrer can make.
- The bursary will be limited to 10 referral awards, which will be awarded on a first-come first-served basis, based on the date of referral via email.
- This award can be held in conjunction with other University of Essex scholarships or bursaries, apart from any other referral awards.

Students who are not eligible

The following students are NOT eligible for this award regardless of meeting the above criteria:

This scholarship award does not apply to deferred entry. Where a referred individual defers entry to the following academic year, the award will be withdrawn, and the referrer will be considered again in line with any bursary terms and conditions that apply in the new proposed year of entry.

How to apply

 Individuals can refer a student to the MA Jungian and Post Jungian Studies course by emailing their full name and email address to <u>pps@essex.ac.uk</u> no later than 10 October 2025.

Confirmation of receipt of the referral will be provided by return email.

Award of the bursary will be made by 28 November 2025 via email, based on the terms and conditions above, including:

- Receipt of the referral to <u>pps@essex.ac.uk</u> by the referrer before 10 October 2025;
- Registration of the new student to the MA programme in October 2025;
- Confirmation from the referred student of the source of the referral by 1 November 2025.

Payment arrangements

- Payment of the award will be made in November 2025, after the final registration date.
- Referrers receiving the award will be contacted via email no later than 28 November 2025 and will need to ensure up-to-date contact information is provided to <u>pps@essex.ac.uk</u>, to ensure that the award can be administered.
