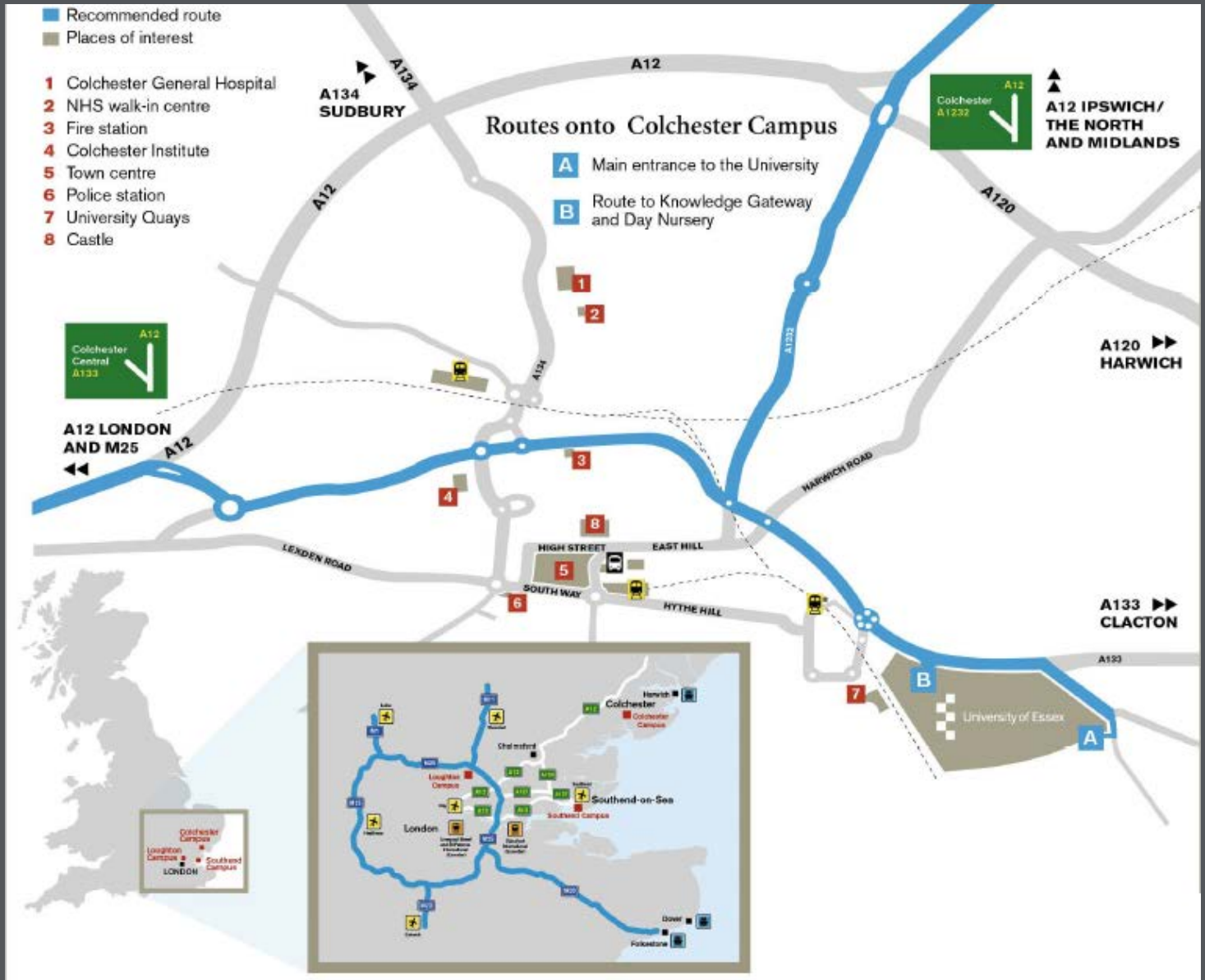




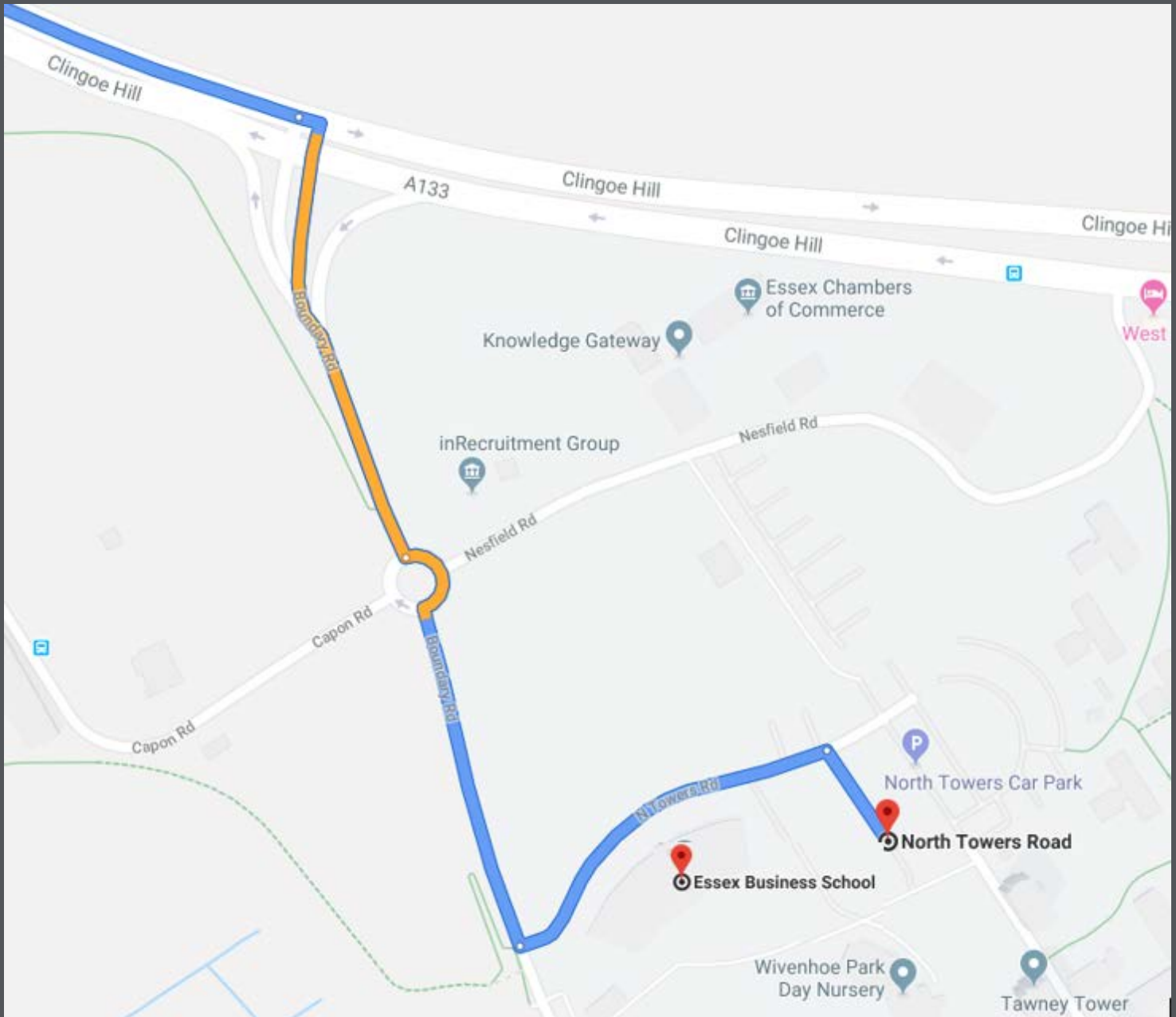
Travelling to our Colchester Campus

By car

For Sat Nav please only use postcode CO4 3SQ. When you arrive in Colchester, follow road signs to the Knowledge Gateway off the A133, marked as route B on the map below.



Continue down Boundary road, straight over the roundabout and then take the first left onto North Towers Road which signposts to the Wivenhoe Park Day Nursery.

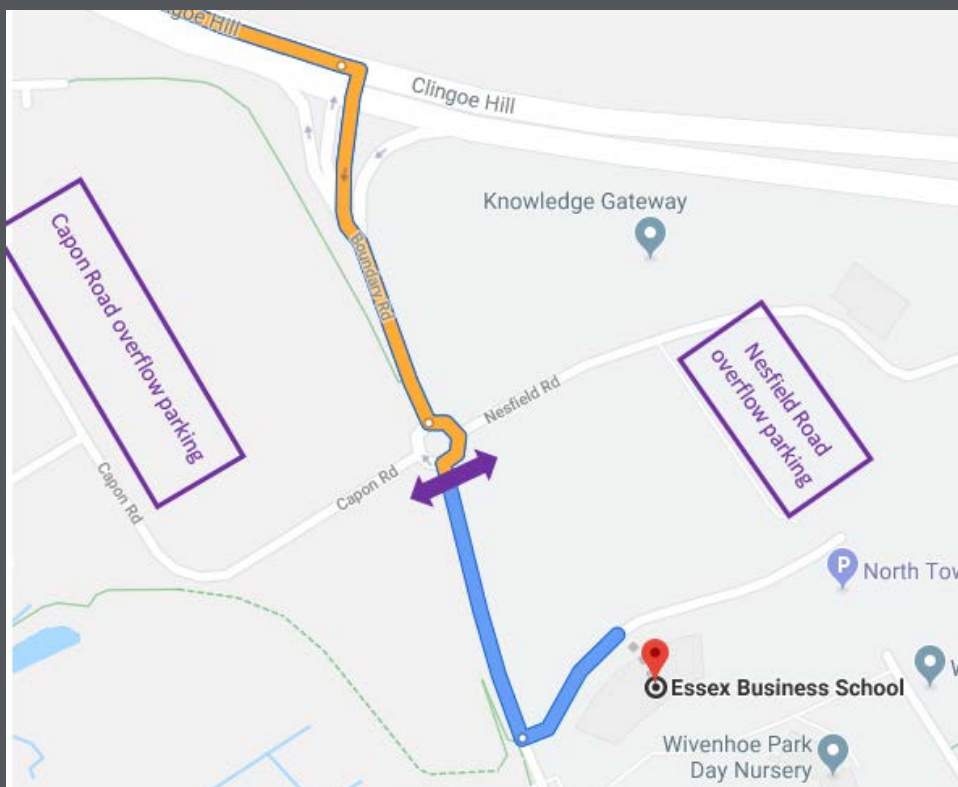


Parking

University of Essex



By train

There are frequent trains from London Liverpool Street to Colchester (also known as Colchester North). The journey takes just under an hour and you can get a bus or taxi direct from the station to us. Our nearest station is Hythe (Essex) which is a 20-minute walk from campus, train services to this station are less frequent.

By bus and coach

The following bus services run through our campus connecting it to and from Colchester town centre, Colchester Station, and Wivenhoe: 61, 62, 74/74A, 75, 76 and 87.

- [First Bus](#) provide most bus services in and around Colchester and the University.
- [The Panther X15 service](#) provides services from Harwich to the University.
- [National Express](#) coaches run services from around the country to our Colchester Campus including from London and UK airports. Please note, for some journeys you may need to change buses before continuing to your destination.

By taxi

There is a taxi rank at Colchester Train Station and in the town centre (High Street). The journey to the University normally takes about 10-20 minutes.
