

University Netball Officer (UNO) Role Description

- Forge links with the local netball community, encouraging and enabling students to gain additional playing opportunities in community setting.
- Act as a key communication point between the netball community and the student population.

- Promote wider netball opportunities, in particular coach, official and volunteer development opportunities.
- Monitor and report to England Netball and your University, the number of students involved in the programmes delivered by the UNO role
- Work alongside relevant University staff and the regional Netball Development Officer
 to ensure that England Netball products and programmes are utilised in the best way
 possible within the University environment.
- Operate in line with England Netball policies highlighted in the Volunteer Agreement

What is the commitment required?

This voluntary role has been designed to complement and fit alongside your academic studies. We hope that you are able to volunteer, on average, approximately four to eight hours per week. We do however, appreciate that there will be times when studies have to take priority, e.g. exam periods.

You will also be expected to attend the national UNO training event in September.
