#### Undergraduate study:

Secondary School Diploma/DEC: 75%, including 60% in English (if taught in English)

We also accept the IB Diploma (standard requirement 30 points)

Bachelor's degree: B+ or GPA 3.0/4 or equivalent

# Postgraduate study (taught):

Bachelor's degree: Minimum requirement - B or GPA 2.7/4
