Undergraduate study:

Previous university/junior college study required—please contact us for more information. If you are taking international high school qualifications these may also be accepted—please contact us for more information. IELTS 6.0, TOEFL 76

We also accept the IB Diploma (standard requirement 30 points).

Postgraduate study (taught):

Bachelor's degree: 65% (Good)/CGPA 2.75 from American University of Cairo. IELTS 6.0-7.5, TOEFL IBT 76-100
