ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Most of our courses will consider:

Undergraduate

12.0-14.0 overall in your French Baccalauréat

Postgraduate

12.5/20 and above in a relevant Bachelors degree.

We also have a range of Foundation Programmes for those who achieve lower than our entry requirements.

English Language REQUIREMENTS

We accept 12 in the French Baccalauréat as an English language qualification. If you're taking an alternative qualification we will also accept IELTS, TOEFL, CAE (Advanced) and CPE (Proficiency).
