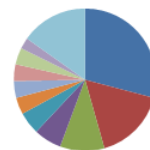
“As an international student, I was very much attracted by the high level of cultural diversity of Essex as it allows me to meet people from around the world, which enables me to widen my perspectives.

- HKDSE—544
- A-levels—BBB
- IB—30

Grade 4 in HKDSE English **OR** IELTS 6.0, TOEFL IBT 76

Postgraduate study (taught):

Minimum requirement—Bachelor's degree: 2:2. IELTS 6.0-7.5, TOEFL IBT 76-100
