### Undergraduate study:

- A-levels—BBB
- IB—30 points
- STPM—BBB
- UEC—Pass all subjects to include a minimum of two subjects at grade A and three subjects at grade B4
- If you are taking international high school qualifications these may also be accepted—please contact us for more information
- IELTS 6.0, TOEFL IBT 76

Minimum requirement—Bachelor's degree: GPA 2.7. IELTS 6.0-7.5, TOEFL IBT 76-100
