Moroccan Baccalaureat: 17. IELTS 6.0, TOEFL IBT 76

We also accept the IB Diploma (standard requirement 30 points).

Minimum requirement—Bachelor's degree: 14. IELTS 6.0-7.5, TOEFL IBT 76-100
