

How to connect to your home network drive (M:) off campus

You can access your home network drive off campus using Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP). We recommend using the FileZilla Client but you can use a different SFTP client if you prefer.

- Download and install the <u>FileZilla Client</u>.
- Open FileZilla and choose File \rightarrow Site Manager... \rightarrow New Site
- Enter a name for the site, for example "My home drive", and then enter the following settings:

Setting	Value
Host	unix4.essex.ac.uk
Port	22
Protocol	SFTP - SSH File Transfer
	Protocol
Logon Type	Normal
User	Enter your University
	username (do not add
	@essex.ac.uk after your
	username)
Password	Enter your University
	password

- Choose Connect.
- Choose **OK** if you're asked to confirm the host's key fingerprint.
- Once you're connected, you'll be able to see all of your files and folders stored in your drive. Drag and drop files to download or upload.
- To disconnect from your drive simply close FileZilla Client.
