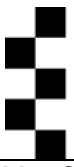

	B: Choose/narrow down the research topic and demonstrate significance/impact of research. 	C: Demonstration of effective project management through the setting of research goals and prioritisation of activities.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Create a detailed, realistic plan of work/timetable for Year 2.</li> <li>▪ Produce Supervisory Panel report written in a clear and self-reflective style</li> <li>▪ Commence and continue data collection</li> </ul>	By end of Term 3 for full-time students; Term 6 for part-time students
	D: Demonstrate the ability to produce work of the quality and quantity in order to complete an MPhil within the 2 year standard period	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Evidence that academic writing is of standard and ability expected at MPhil level, including adequate referencing and language skills</li> </ul>	By end of Term 3 for full-time students, Term 6 for part-time students
